



Instructions for Quilt Entries

ENTRY FORM

1. Fill out one form for each quilt and/or item to be displayed.
2. Items submitted should not have been shown in a previous QCG show and should have been made (at least in part) by the guild member.
3. Deadline for turning in entry forms is the September Guild meeting, but please turn your completed forms in as soon as possible. I will collect them at the August and September meetings or you can mail them to Tammy Lawson, 7616 Norma Jean Dr., Indpls, IN 46259

PREPARING YOUR ENTRY

1. Quilts must be prepared for hanging by attaching a four inch wide fabric sleeve to the top reverse side of the item. No sleeve required for antique quilts and miniatures.
2. Antique quilts will not be hung but will be displayed on the stage.
3. Miniatures will be pinned to a sheet.
4. A hanger should be provided for clothing.
5. Each item must have a 3" x 5" cloth label sewn securely to the reverse side of the quilt in the lower left hand corner (looking at the back of the quilt). Please find an appropriate place to put a label on the other items. The label should include your name, address and phone number.
6. Each item must be delivered in a cloth bag or pillowcase. NO PLASTIC BAGS!

DELIVERING YOUR ENTRIES

1. All items to be displayed in the quilt show must be delivered on Wed., Sept. 21 between 4 and 7 pm to Greenwood United Methodist Church. The registration committee will be in the large meeting room to receive your quilts. You will be given numbered tags to pin on each quilt and pillowcase. You will also be given the quilt information placards which you will place inside the pillowcase.
2. You will be given receipts for your items which must be presented when items are picked up on Sat, Sept 24.
3. **No quilts will be accepted if we have not previously received an entry form.**
4. All items must be picked up immediately after the show on Sat., Sept 24 between 4 and 5pm
